

1 Bee Mortality

In the last few years so many bees have died that experts now speak of "bee mortality". And this is worldwide. Even more endangered than the honey bee are the wild bees and other insects that are also very important for our environment. The main causes of bee mortality are:

- Loss of biodiversity in meadows, fields and hedges
- Lack of biotope networking due to overgrowth of arable land
- Insecticides that are used in agriculture, forestry, but also in public areas and private gardens.
- Surface damage due to building and sealing
- Fragmentation of habitats, e.g. through streets

In addition, there are not enough flowering wild plants for the bees as a source of food. Bees weakened by lack of food and toxins get diseases and parasites more quickly.
